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### DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** Noncode.

**Synopsis:** Paid personal leave. Urges the legislative council to assign to a study committee during the 2017 legislative interim the topic of paid personal leave from employment.

**Effective:** July 1, 2017.

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning employment.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2017] (a) As used in this
- 2 SECTION, "legislative council" refers to the legislative council
- 3 created by IC 2-5-1.1-1.
- 4 (b) As used in this SECTION, "study committee" means either
- 5 of the following:
- 6 (1) A statutory committee established under IC 2-5-1.3-4.
- 7 (2) An interim study committee established under
- 8 IC 2-5-1.3-14.
- 9 (c) The legislative council is urged to assign to a study
- 10 committee, during the 2017 legislative interim, the topic of paid
- 11 personal leave from employment, including leave for reasons of:
- 12 (1) family leave;
- 13 (2) leave to care for a seriously ill family member; and
- 14 (3) sick leave for an employee.
- 15 (d) If the topic described in subsection (c) is assigned to a study
- 16 committee, the study committee shall, not later than November 1,
- 17 2017, issue a final report to the legislative council containing the
- 18 study committee's findings and recommendations, including any
